

Best publication Award in Breast Cancer Research

Journal of Carcinogenesis is inviting manuscripts in the area of breast cancer research for the contest for best publication award. The manuscripts can be from any one of the categories described below.

1. Original research articles

Manuscripts that significantly advances our knowledge of breast carcinogenesis

2. Early detection of breast cancer

Manuscripts that describes novel technique or improvised version of an existing technique or an outstanding publication that presents data obtained using novel techniques.

3. Provocative and paradigm shifting hypotheses on breast carcinogenesis.

Hypotheses that link new or less known carcinogens to breast cancer, hypotheses that link new or less known agents to carcinoprevention, hypotheses that implicate involvement of novel targets or molecular pathways to breast carcinogenesis.

4. Mini reviews

Critical and informative reviews on breast carcinogenesis

Selection of the winners

The contest opens on July 1st 2009. Manuscripts that are submitted and accepted for publication in the journal of carcinogenesis after peer review between July 1st 2009 and June 30th 2010 will be eligible for consideration for the award. Journal of carcinogenesis uses double-blind approach to ensure fair and professional peer review. The peer reviewers will be asked to rate the manuscripts on various criteria. All manuscripts entered in the contest and are published will be assessed by a panel of independent judges and the winning publication will be selected based on the recommendations from the judges. All the authors will be named in the award and the corresponding author will receive the award on behalf of all the authors. The corresponding author is encouraged to use discretion in choosing the number of co-authors.

The final decision will be communicated to the contestants by the end of September 2010 and the awards will be presented in the month of October 2010 during the breast cancer awareness month. The decisions of the judges are final and are not subject to any revisions or negotiations.

The winning publication will receive \$2000 and certificate. The research accomplishments of the authors will be publicized via the web sites of the journal of carcinogenesis and Carcinogenesis Foundation.
